


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


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


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# "Leveraging technologies for a better society" By Cambrian House Of Student Startup (CHOSS)




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### Webinar on "Innovations using Sensors on Raspberry PI"

The workshop was led well by Dr. S.Geetha from BNMIT. The workshop commenced at 10.00 A.M. and was split into four sessions daily. The following topics were discussed in detail with the students.

- Installing the Software, Fundamentals of Arduino Programming
- Introduction to RaspberryPi
- About the RaspberryPi Board: Hardware Layout
- Configuring RaspberryPi, Programming RaspberryPi with Python
- Wireless Temperature Monitoring System Using Pi
- DS18B20 Temperature Sensor, Connecting Raspberry Pi via SSH
- Remote access to RaspberryPi, Smart and Connected Cities
- An IoT Strategy for Smarter Cities, Smart City IoT Architecture


He explained the registration process to start a new venture. After the session, there was an interactive session with students. Total participants were around 120, including students and faculty members.

The key takeaways from the session are as follows:



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




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- 1. Introduction to Entrepreneurship.

The student, Ms.Y M Vishnupriya, gave a Vote of Thanks by extending heart-filled gratitude to the Cambridge Institute of technology.






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#### **Workshop on Road Safety and Traffic Awareness Program**





#### **Guest Lecture on Data Analytics using Python**



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
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






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### Workshop on Embedded systems using Arduino – Ignitron 2022

In association with the ECE department and the Aadya Foundation of collective thoughts, organized a session under the guidance of Mr.Shivapanchakshari T G(Prof & HOD in E.C. Dept.) Mr. Veerrappa S C (Asst Prof., E.C. Dept.) and Mr. Girish H (Associate Prof., E.C. Dept.) for the sixth-semester students of ECE on 28 May 2022, to give a hands-on experience on Robotics, Sensor interface, and Embedded systems.

The workshop includes theory and practical sessions on the basics of Microcontrollers, Microprocessors, serial protocols, etc. The students got training in Arduino IDE, C Programming for Arduino, Sensor interface, and Analog and digital systems. Later, the workshop continued with a detailed understanding of the Arduino hardware and serial interface to the Arduino Uno board.


The Students were encouraged to write programs in C to perform various tasks like blinking an LED, implementing a 3-bit binary counter, and displaying the counts using an LED. The students made to interface an analog sensor (smoke sensor) and a Bluetooth module to Arduino. The workshop includes the construction of a robot and controlling by passing the commands from a Bluetooth module interfaced to Arduino. Participants received detailed information regarding motor drivers and how to interface them with Arduino to drive motors. The final task was to build a Bluetooth-controlled robot.

The students were motivated to perform as a team and accomplish the tasks given. Students' eagerness to take part in the workshop, their thirst for knowledge, their team spirit, and their passion for winning, as well as their understanding of embedded systems. A count of 85 students got benefited from this event.




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
